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#### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

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#### **Warning:**

- 1. Do not, drill, cut, weld or otherwise modify the towbar.
- If you are using electric welding on a motor vehicle, <u>always</u> check that the vehicle is not equipped with electronic engine or instrument management equipment. Failure to do so could <u>destroy</u> any onboard computers. If in doubt, check with the vehicle's manufacturer.
- 1. General: Ensure all hardware items have been included refer to assembly diagram.
- 2. It is recommended that the instructions are read through and completely understood before making any attempt to fit this product.
- 3. Be wary of any changes to vehicle designs or other accessories that may conflict with the installation of this product.
- 4. Before drilling ensure that the area is clear of fuel, electrical & other components.
- 5. All holes drilled into the body panels shall have all burrs & swarf removed then coated with a suitable rust preventative paint.
- 6. The high tensile fasteners supplied with this product were used to achieve the specified rating. If replacement is required ensure that fasteners of the same rating & quality are used. Contact an authorised **Hayman Reese** dealer if further information is required.
- 7. Ensure that all hardware is fastened to torque list below check fasteners on regular basis.
- 8. Towbar load rating sticker provided with this product shall be conspicuously located on inside rear end of the driver's door. (See diagram below).
- 9. Hayman Reese recommends that you check your tow ball to ensure that it complies with the Australian standards **AS 4177.2.**
- 10. **PLEASE NOTE**: It is advised to remove your lug or tbm when not actually towing so as to produce a clear view of the vehicles registration plate if obscured, and to also provide maximum available departure angle.


#### Tow bar Maintenance and Care.

Hayman Reese recommends that bolt torque's, as listed below, are routinely and regularly inspected and checked for correct tension. Replace any worn or defective parts.

We recommended to remove Tow Ball Mounts (TBM's, tongues or lugs) when not being used for any considerable length of time.

So as to avoid injury, when not towing it is suggested that the tongue, Pull Pin and R-clip are removed then stored in a safe, clean and dry place, away from excessive moisture.

Hitch Pull Pins and spring "R" clips are regularly checked for proper installation. Replace any worn or defective parts.



1. Remove screws x 2 from underneath the bumper.

Note - Petrol version has 2 screws, but Diesel version has 3 screws.



2. Remove the screws x 4, from the wheel arch, as shown in Figure 3.

Note – Repeat the step for passenger side.

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


Figure 4 – Remove screws.

3. From inside the boot, remove the cap and the nut inside, to remove the light, as shown in Figure 4.


Figure 5 – Remove bumper nut from inside boot.

Note – If the towbar has to be removed, the impact beam should be fitted back on.

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


Figure 7 – Bumper Cut Illustration.

- 10. Detach the skirt from the bumper and make a cut, as shown in the illustration in Figure 7. Find the centreline, measure 20mm from the bottom edge, cut 115mm, making a 70mm wide cut along the centreline.
- 11. Fit the bumper trim (item 20) on the portion of the bumper being cut.
- 12. Refit the bumper and rear lights in the reverse order.
- 13. Affix the load rating label, as shown on page 2.

3. Remove the floor carpet cover (1) and fold the rear seats (2) down flat.



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




- 13. If the vehicle is fitted with a factory subwoofer (1) remove by first removing all the fasteners.
- 14. Disconnect the subwoofer connector (2).



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

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- 15. Route the trailer harness (P/No 100249-WL) (1) from the RHS of the vehicle along the rear of the luggage compartment towards the LHS of the vehicle.
- 16. Drill a Ø31mm hole in the highlighted area (2). File down and rough or sharp edges and spray with rust inhibitor.

17. In the engine bay attach the trailer harness power wire (04825) (1) to the unused terminal (2) using an M5 nut (not supplied).

18. Route the trailer harness power wire (04825)(1) behind the fuse boxes towards the firewall.



- 19. Route the trailer harness power wire (04825)(1) down through the engine bay towards the chassis.
- Route the trailer harness power wire (04825)
   (1) along the LHS of the vehicle towards the rear of the vehicle.




Keep harness power wire clear of any heat sources or moving parts.

21. Route the trailer harness power wire (04825) (1) under the vehicle shroud along the LHS vehicle chassis towards the rear of the vehicle.



- 23. Route the tail harness (tail length 1200mm) (3) through the previously drilled out hole.
- 24. Route the trailer harness power wire (1) from outside the vehicle through the trailer harness grommet (2) inside the luggage compartment.



- 25. Adjust the tail harness grommet (2) into place ensuring it is seated correctly. Secure the tail harness grommet in place with a cable tie (not supplied)
- Mount the tail harness socket(1) to the towbar mounting bracket using M4 fasteners (not supplied)
- 27. Route the trailer harness terminals (1) to the RHS taillight harness wires (3).
- 28. Following the table on the right, connect the ezy taps (2) to the vehicle harness wires (3) then connect the trailer harness terminals (1) to the corresponding wires (3).



If vehicle is petrol version  $\ensuremath{\mathsf{BLUE/RED}}$  reverse wire will be located on the LHS.

29. In the LHS of the luggage compartment following the table on the right, connect the ezy taps (2) to the harness wires (3) then connect the trailer harness terminals (1) to the corresponding wires.



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


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

32. Connect the 16-way trailer harness connector (1) to the ECU (2).



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

33. Adhere the ECU (1) to the sheet metal on the RHS of the luggage compartment.



- 34. Test the Trailer Harness function using a Light Board or multimeter.
- 35. Secure all Harnesses using cables ties (not supplied).
- 36. Refit all removed parts and secure all fasteners, ensuring there are no squeaks or rattles.
- 37. Place instructions in glove box after fitment

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
